What is IB MYP?

The MYP is a whole school program in which all students experience inquiry-based learning rooted in service and authentic real-world connections.

Through the IB's Approaches to Learning, the IB Learner Profile traits, and an experiential curriculum that includes connections course offerings in areas of design, arts, physical education, and world language, Beechwood Middle School will cultivate application of skills to guarantee continuous relevant learning.

What courses do students take?

MYP schools structure curriculum through 8 specific areas at all grades:

- Arts (Art, Band, Chorus, Creative Drama, Musical Theater, Orchestra)
- Design (Innovation Lab, Programming Lab, STEM Lab, Yearbook, NewsShow)
- Individuals and Societies (Social Studies)
- Language and Literature (English Language Arts)
