

LHS Continued-Learning Quarantine Procedures

While your child is quarantined, we are committed to providing continued access to a high quality learning experience. If a student is quarantined through exposure to COVID-19, but otherwise not experiencing symptoms, he or she is expected to meet assignment deadlines, participate in class activities, and maintain contact with all teachers. Students must be engaged in learning while virtual.

Schoology is the primary platform we use to provide learning resources and assignments for our students. On Schoology, a student will find each teacher's Week at a Glance (WAG), which provides learning objectives and required assignments for the course. The WAG includes contact information for the teacher, links to Zoom meetings, and a schedule of meeting times or due dates.

Teachers will be available to support students individually through office hours or sometimes through synchronous participation in class through Zoom.

The Week at a Glance (WAG)	A Week at a Glance (WAG) is posted on Schoology for every class which includes materials, assignments, and directions for engaging in learning experiences.
Communication	Students & families should email teachers to notify them about your quarantine timeline. Questions about instruction? Email teachers first about instructional needs. If you need additional support, please do not hesitate to reach out to their counselor or administrator.
Assistance	Teachers offer office hours during their planning for clarification, support, and feedback. These times are located on the class specific WAG. If you need WiFi access at home, email Will Verburg at wwerburg@lexington1.net . Hotspots take about a week to get to families.

Parents, you play a big role in supporting your child's success while in quarantine. Here are some suggestions for how you can help your child.

- Identify a dedicated space at home for your student to learn.
- Ensure he/she has 24/7 access to reliable internet to use to connect the district issued device (not a cellular connection through a mobile device.)
- Monitor his/her daily progress and check understanding of learning outcomes.
- Communicate with teachers and other school personnel.
- Provide consistent encouragement and motivation for your student(s).



What will students and parents see in PowerSchool?

Parents and students will typically see a numerical grade for each assignment. For some assignments, they may see the following symbols:

- Collected: means the student has submitted the assignment. This serves as a record-keeping feature.
 - **Exempt:** means the student is not required to submit this assignment.
 - **Incomplete:** means the student is missing part of the assignment. (Teacher will follow up with student with support on completing the assignment.)
 - **Missing assignment**: means the student has not submitted this assignment at all.
 - **Comment Box:** means the teacher put a specific note regarding this assignment. Click on the box to read the details.

Schoology is a dynamic platform that allows teachers and students to work digitally and to communicate with each other on both computers and mobile devices.

With Schoology, students can submit homework assignments, participate in interactive discussions, receive announcements and feedback, take assessments and collaborate with their peers.

Teachers use Schoology to monitor student progress and activity in order to ensure a safe, secure and controlled environment.

Parents also have access to the system, and are encouraged to view teacher and student activity. Contact your student's school in order to receive your parent Schoology access code and directions explaining how to establish your parent account.

Please view the <u>parent activation video</u> to learn how to use your access code to establish a Schoology account. Note that this video is not viewable on a Lexington One Student Device. Additionally, you can view <u>directions on how to establish your account</u> and an <u>overview of how to navigate your account</u>. You can easily access your student's grades and attendance using the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u>. Parents and students can also download a PowerSchool mobile application (available for iPhones or Android telephones).

If you have not already created a PowerSchool Lexington District One parent account, just follow these steps.

- 1.) Contact each child's school for PowerSchool parent Access ID and password.
- 2.) Once you have a parent Access ID and password for each of your children, click here and go to the "Create Account" link.

It is best to use the same email address for this account as the email address you originally provided to your child's school.

Once you create your PowerSchool account, you can elect to receive emails with information about your child's grades and/or attendance. Just set the "Email Notification" while you are in the PowerSchool Parent Portal.
