

Student Council Representatives

Each Base Camp chooses one student to represent their group at Student Council (StuCo) meetings. Representatives are responsible for relaying information from StuCo meetings to their Base Camp. The following expectations are required for each representative.

Eligibility to Participate

- All StuCo representatives must maintain a C average or better in all courses to remain a member of the organization.
- All StuCo representatives must regularly attend StuCo meetings.
- All StuCo representatives who receive three or more referrals during the school year will be placed on probation as a StuCo member and will be ineligible to hold an elected position during the next school year.

Probation

- Representatives who have two unexcused absences, fail to maintain a C average, or receive three or more referrals during a school year will be placed on probation.
- Probation consists of, but is not limited to, the inability to attend StuCo trips and conferences unless circumstances are approved by StuCo advisors in advance.
- Probation timeframes are determined by StuCo advisors based on the reason for probation.

Termination

- Students who violate probation by having excessive absences, failing to maintain a C average for multiple grading periods, and/or receiving five or more referrals during a school year will be terminated from StuCo.
- Termination means the student will no longer be able to–
 - Represent the student's Base Camp;
 - Attend meetings, events, trips, or conferences;
 - Run for officer positions the next school year; and
 - Apply for membership the next school year.
- If an officer is terminated from their position, the position will be filled by a blind ballot election by StuCo representatives and approved by StuCo advisors.
