- \$800-\$1,600 per year scholarship
- Must be a US citizen
- Must be attending or planning to attend an accredited Technical school, college, or university within the US.
- Must have a 2.5 GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
- Stop by the Counseling Office to pick up an application
- **Application must be postmarked NO LATER THAN March 25, 2019**

Ann D. Pitts Memorial Scholarship (Lexington Women's Club)

- Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher

- HS senior planning to attend full-time at a US accredited four-year college or university within the fifty states or District of Columbia.
- You must have demonstrated leadership abilities through participating in community services or other extracurricular activities.
- Combined adjusted income of the parent(s) cannot exceed \$50,000
- Stop by the Counseling Office to pick up an application
- **Deadline: Must be received or postmarked ON or BEFORE March 31, 2019**

Lexington County Clemson Club

- \$4,500 scholarship (\$1,500 for freshman year with a possible \$1,000 for the next 3 year if grades are acceptable)
- You must be accepted by Clemson University (NOT the Bridge Program) and plan to attend in the Fall of 2019
- Stop by the Counseling Office to pick up a copy of the application
- **Deadline: Must be postmarked NO LATER THAN March 8, 2019 to be considered**

Lexington County Herb Bunch Scholarship Application

- \$2,000 scholarship per year
- Must be going to college to study agriculture or related majors
- Must maintain a 3.0 GPA to keep the scholarship
- Stop by the Counseling Office to pick up an application
- **Deadline: Must be received NO LATER THAN March 15, 2019**

Lexington District One Office Professionals Scholarship

- \$1,000 scholarship
- HS Senior who plans to attend an accredited two or four year institution in the Fall of 2019
- Must be pursuing a degree in a Business program (Computer Science, Advertising, Marketing, Accounting, etc)
- Must have a 3.0 GPA in HS
- Must be a US citizen and a resident of SC
- Demonstrates commitment to the business profession through grades and character.

Mid-Carolina Electric Cooperative – Touchstone Energy Scholarship

- \$5,000 scholarship
- Must be a legal US resident living in SC
- Must be a HS senior
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Must plan to attend an accredited college in the US during the 2019-2020 academic school year.
- Stop by the Counseling Office for more information. Applications are online.
- **Deadline: February 28, 2019**

Richland County Alumnae Chapter – Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Scholarship

- Award value is \$1,250 each. Eleven scholarships will be awarded.
- This is for any African American student planning to attend a technical school, college, or university in the Fall of 2019
- Application and all instructions may be picked up in the Counseling Office
- **Deadline: Must be postmarked NO LATER THAN March 22, 2019**

South Carolina Association of Extension Administrative Professionals Scholarship (SCAEAP)

- \$1,000 scholarship
- Must be pursuing a 2-yr or 4-yr degree in administrative office technology, accounting, business management, or business administration field
- Must have at least a “B” average or better.
- Must be a resident of SC
- Stop by the Counseling Office to pick up the application
- **Deadline: Must be received NO LATER THAN March 8, 2019**

SCCAWS Educator’s Scholarship

- \$1,000 scholarship
- Female planning to enroll in college and major in education
- An additional \$1,000 scholarship is awarded from these applications for a Female Scholar Athlete

- **Deadline: March 26, 2019 (Must be turned in to the Counseling Office NO LATER THAN March 22, 2019).**

SCCAWS Medical Scholarship

- \$1,000 scholarship
- Female planning to enroll in college and major in the medical field

- **Deadline: March 26, 2019 (Must be turned in to the Counseling Office NO LATER THAN March 22, 2019)**

SC Law Enforcement Officers Foundation Scholarship

- \$3,000 award and (2) \$2,000 awards
- Must be a HS senior in SC and a legal resident of SC for at least one year
- Must attend college, university or technical school in SC
- Must be of good moral character and reputation
- Application may be picked up in the Counseling Office or you may go online to www.scleo.org to print one out.
- **Deadline: February 22, 2019**

South Carolina Soil and Water Conservation Society Scholarship

- \$1,000 Scholarship
- Recipient must be a resident of SC
- Must be studying in the field of conservation/natural resources
- For part-time or full-time student at a college, university, or technical school in the Fall of 2019
- You may download the app at www.scwcs.org or stop by the Counseling Office and pick one up
- **Deadline: Must be postmarked NO LATER THAN March 15, 2019**

SC State Fair Scholarship

- \$6,000 scholarship (50 scholarships will be awarded)
- Must be a full time resident of SC and a senior in high school
- Must complete the full application online and attach a current photo (preferably senior photo)
- Must attend a public college, university, or technical college in SC
- Stop by the Counseling Office for more information
- Application may be found at www.scstatefair.org/scholarships
- **Deadline: March 15, 2019**

SunTrust Off to College Scholarship Sweepstakes

- Eligibility NOT based on GPA or financial need
- **One winner chosen every two weeks from September 10, 2018 through May 13, 2019**
- Apply online at www.suntrust.com and type scholarship in the search bar.

TEACH Grants – new program for future teachers

- Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education Grants (TEACH) will be available at some colleges and universities beginning this academic year.
