#### **NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM**

Our lunch program offers a variety of hot and cold entrées, along with fresh fruit and vegetables. Lunch includes an entrée of lean protein and whole grains, 2 servings of fruit, 2 servings of vegetables, and 1% white or skim chocolate milk.

#### SCHOOL BREAKFAST PROGRAM

Elementary schools have a breakfast kiosk service which allows students to take breakfast to their classrooms, while Middle and High school students will come through the serving



line in the cafeteria. Breakfast includes an entrée with whole grains and/or lean protein, fruit, 100% juice, and 1% white or skim chocolate milk.



### **MEALS ARE NO COST FOR ALL STUDENTS**

USDA has extended free breakfast and lunch to all Lexington One students through the 2021-2022 school year. Although meals are no cost to students, we strongly encourage you to complete a meal benefit application.
