INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES

Four will be going to Acadia National Park, one to Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park, and one to Cumberland Island National Seashore.

OPERATIONS

From Joint Municipal Water & Sewer:

The Commission is extending a 24" water main along the southern edge of Augusta Highway from Hermitage Road to the corner of Augusta Hwy and Pisgah Church in front of LTC. We have worked with the school district and procured an easement at the corner of Pisgah Church and Augusta Hwy to complete a tie into our existing main. As part of this construction, it will be necessary for us to dig a bore pit at the intersection and bore a 48" casing under Pisgah Church Road. These activities are scheduled to occur during the summer when school is out. We will keep you updated as to the status of this, but most likely is about six weeks out. However, we are going to begin the installation of the main along the southern side of Augusta Hwy beginning at the current Hendrix Farms Development. In the past, we have noticed joggers from the school (I assume the cross country team) running in this area and wanted to give you a heads up as to this activity so that you could notify your staff and students as you deem necessary.



We are excited to see Joint Muncipal's work come to fruition in collaboration with the design by LHS's fine arts department.

Land Disposal - We are working closely with the Office of School Facilities to appropriately navigate the land disposal process for the two properties the Board approved for disposal. Once that process is completed we will move forward with the disposal process on the two properties concurrently.

Most USA School Leaders Like their Jobs

Despite the long list of challenges school and district leaders have faced over the past few years, 80 percent say they are satisfied with their job, and nearly two-thirds said they'd still advise their younger self to pursue a career in education leadership. Some 277 district leaders and 185 school leaders participated in the survey, conducted by *Ed Week's* research center.
