

LEXINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT ONE
Board Meeting Minutes
September 27, 2022

The Lexington County School District One Board of Trustees held a meeting on Tuesday, September 27, 2022, in the Lexington County School District One's Central Services Building One located at 100 Tarrar Springs Road in Lexington, South Carolina. The meeting was livestreamed on the Lexington One YouTube channel and a video of the meeting has been uploaded to the YouTube channel and LexOne video website. It is also on the Board Meeting Agendas and Minutes webpage. The livestream encountered technical difficulties.

1.0 Call to Order 6:00 P.M.

Chair Green called to order the general session of the September 27, 2022, board meeting at 6:00 p.m. The district is in compliance with the S.C. 3.0 Discussion of Superintendent Search Process

3.1 Community and Staff Feedback from Candidate Visits — SCSBA

Ms. Judy LeGrand, South Carolina School Boards Association, presented feedback from stakeholders on the superintendent finalists. Each candidate individually spent one full day, approximately 13.5 hours, in the district. Candidates met with principals, teachers, staff, visited schools and classrooms, toured the district and had a community meet and greet. Finally, each candidate filmed a video Q & A. Stakeholders were provided an email address to submit anonymous feedback. 162 responses were received from community members, faculty, staff, and parents. Information is available to the board to consider in their decision making. There was discussion among the board with Ms. LeGrand regarding whether she redacted any identifying information and/or included all feedback.

4.0 Executive Session

Chair Green called for a motion to enter executive session. A motion was made that the board enter executive session for discussion of personnel matters in the superintendent search and to receive legal advice regarding the superintendent search. The motion was seconded and approved.
